To Our Customer,

In June 2007 the EU (European Union) enacted chemical registration requirements known as REACH (Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and restriction of Chemical Substances). The goal of REACH is to identify substances that are manufactured or imported into the EU.

Articles 57 & 59(10) of REACH, the SVHC (Substances of Very High Concern) Candidate list (<https://echa.europa.eu/web/guest/candidate-list-table>) **pertains to articles and therefore DynaQuip products. EU customers importing articles containing more than .1% by weight of any substance on this SVHC list may need to comply with special reporting requirements.**

SVHC – Annex XVII - Amended as of **June 27, 2024**, ECHA(European Chemicals Agency) has placed 241 substances on the Candidate List that must not be used without prior authorization of the ECHA. (Reference Article 33(1)). \*ECHA/NR/24/19

**REGISTRATION** - DynaQuip Controls does not manufacture chemicals, preparations or articles that intentionally release substances under normal operation conditions and therefore do not fit within the scope of entities obligated to pre-register with REACH.

***As of the date of this letter, to the best of our knowledge, all of the products and accessories found in DynaQuip's catalog (exclusive of JE Series and MA Series Actuators) do not contain any substances on the SVHC (235) Candidate list. Please be advised that DynaQuip does not analyze for these substances.***

DynaQuip Controls intends to monitor the developments of REACH and cooperate with requests for information from our customers regarding REACH compliance.
