Regulatory basis

Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH), as amended, establishes obligations for substances, mixtures and articles. Under Articles 57 and 59, substances may be identified as Substances of Very High Concern (SVHCs) and included in the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) Candidate List for eventual inclusion in Annex XIV.

As of February 4, 2026, the ECHA Candidate List contains **253 entries**. Inclusion on the Candidate List does not by itself prohibit a substance. It triggers information and, where applicable, notification duties when a Candidate List substance is present above 0.1% w/w in an article.

Product declaration

Based on supplier declarations and material information reasonably available to DynaQuip, the covered products do not contain any Candidate List SVHC above 0.1% weight by weight (w/w) in any constituent article.

This declaration covers all products and accessories in DynaQuip's catalog **except JE Series and MA Series Actuators**, which are outside the scope of this statement. The 0.1% threshold is evaluated at the level of each constituent article, consistent with Article 33 and applicable EU interpretation.

DynaQuip does not routinely perform analytical testing for every Candidate List substance. This declaration is based on supplier information, material declarations, specifications and other information reasonably available as of the effective date. It does not assert that Candidate List substances are absent at concentrations at or below 0.1% w/w.

Communication, SCIP and registration

For the covered products, the available information does not indicate an Article 33 communication duty or a SCIP notification duty arising from a Candidate List substance above 0.1% w/w. SCIP obligations arise under Article 9(1)(i) of the EU Waste Framework Directive and apply to obligated suppliers placing qualifying articles on the EU market. EU importers and other supply-chain actors remain responsible for their own duties.

DynaQuip is a United States manufacturer of finished articles and does not manufacture substances or mixtures in the EU. The covered articles are not intended to release substances under normal or reasonably foreseeable conditions of use; therefore, registration under REACH Article 7(1) is not expected to apply to DynaQuip's supply of these articles. This statement does not replace an EU importer's independent assessment of Articles 7, 33, Annex XIV, Annex XVII or other applicable requirements.

Ongoing review
