

PFAS Content and Regulatory Compliance Statement

Effective date: August 3, 2026

Purpose and scope

This statement describes PFAS content reasonably known to DynaQuip Controls Corporation and summarizes the current status of relevant U.S. federal reporting requirements. PFAS definitions vary among jurisdictions; there is no single universal PFAS list. The TSCA Chemical Substance Inventory is not itself a complete PFAS declaration list. This statement applies generally to DynaQuip catalog products; product-specific configurations should be confirmed when a customer or jurisdiction requires a substance-level or concentration-level disclosure.

PFAS content declaration

DynaQuip cannot certify that all products are PFAS-free. Certain products intentionally contain fluoropolymer materials, including PTFE and reinforced PTFE (RTFE), and certain product options or configurations may contain perfluoroelastomer (FFKM). These materials may fall within broad structure-based PFAS definitions used by regulatory authorities.

DynaQuip does not intentionally synthesize PFAS chemical substances. Fluoropolymers and perfluoroelastomers are used as functional materials where chemical resistance, temperature capability, low friction, sealing performance or durability is required. Presence and concentration vary by product, component and supplier formulation. Product-specific information is available to the extent reasonably ascertainable from bills of material and supplier documentation.

Current U.S. federal reporting status

TSCA section 8(a)(7) and 40 CFR Part 705 establish a one-time reporting and recordkeeping rule for persons that manufactured, including imported, covered PFAS or PFAS-containing articles for commercial purposes during the statutory lookback period beginning January 1, 2011. The rule is a reporting rule; it does not by itself prohibit PFAS in products and does not impose product testing or labeling requirements.

As of this statement's effective date, EPA has delayed the start of the submission period until **60 days after the effective date of a forthcoming final action on the substantive rule revisions, or January 31, 2027, whichever occurs first**. The reporting period remains six months, with an additional six months for qualifying small manufacturers whose reporting obligations arise exclusively from article imports. EPA's proposed exemptions for imported articles, low-concentration PFAS and certain other activities are not yet final and are not relied upon in this statement.

DynaQuip is evaluating its applicable manufacturing and import activities and information known or reasonably ascertainable under the final requirements in effect. This declaration is not a representation that DynaQuip or another supply-chain participant has no reporting obligation.

Jurisdictional limitations and continuing review

State, federal and non-U.S. PFAS requirements may use different definitions, thresholds, reporting dates, product categories and exemptions. Accordingly, this document is a general content and regulatory-status statement, not a blanket certification of compliance with every PFAS law. DynaQuip will review material supplier information and applicable regulatory changes and update this statement as appropriate.
